



Announcement of the Uthaithani Provincial Administrative Organization
Subject: Policy of not accepting neither gifts nor profits from performing duties (No Gift Policy)
Fiscal year 2026

The cabinet on 8th December 2020 approved the National Reformation Plan on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct (revised version) by specifying important reform activities (Big Rock). An important reformation activity stated in the 4th reformation activity regarding the development of The Thai civil service system to become transparent and free of benefit, and clause 1.1 of the 1st Goal is to have all governmental agencies declare that all their officials do not accept any kinds of presents and gifts from performing duties (No Gift Policy)

In order to strengthen the organization culture as well as honesty and integrity in carrying out tasks with virtue and ethics, performing duties without conflict of interest, the Uthaithani Provincial Administrative Organization has set up the Policy of Not Accepting Any kinds of Presents and Gifts from Performing Duties (No Gift Policy) to Prevent and Suppress of Corruption and Misconduct as follows:

1. All of executives, civil officials and officers of the Uthaithani Provincial Administrative Organization do not accept any kinds of presents and gifts from performing duties both before and after performing our duties which would cause corruption and misconduct on festivals and special occasions. In the case where it is necessary and inevitable, all must comply with the Office of the Prime Minister, who issued the Regulation on the Provision or Acceptance of Gift of Governmental Officials, B.E. 2565 (2022)

2. All of executives, civil officials and officers of the Uthaithani Provincial Administrative Organization do not seek to obtain presents and gifts or any other unlawful benefits.

This Announcement shall be informed, and all of executives, officers and personnel of the Uthaithani Provincial Administrative Organization are to strongly comply with this Announcement.

This shall be effective from now on.
